We have listed just one (1) for every day of the week. They need our support especially now while there is so much turmoil in the area.

Bethel is supporting a seminary student, Enos Muhiwa, at Justo Mwale Theological School in Zambia. He is preparing to be a pastor for the people of his country and Bethel has a special privilege in not only supporting him monetarily but in prayer.

Rev. Ted and Mrs. Sue Wright, missionaries from the Outreach Foundation who oversee the theological college and the work of the Outreach Foundation in three (3) countries: Zambia, Mozambique and Zimbabwe have urgently requested prayer from us...

- 1) for the political situation in Zimbabwe which has resulted in the persecution of Christians as they gather for worship, famine, and in the thousands of refugees fleeing the country.
- 2) for stabilization of the country and for the new leadership to be recognized by the current corrupt government.
- 3) for Paul, a brave Zimbabwean Presbyterian pastor, as he stands up against the corrupt government and is himself persecuted.
- 4) for Pastor Nedson who oversees some fifty (50) churches in Mozambique, most of who do not have a pastor.
- 5) for Pastor Sebber who has been very ill with Malaria. Pray for his health that he may be fully restored to his important work.
- 6) for Namumu orphanage in Zambia where eighty (80) orphans are fed clothed and schooled with a minimum budget. The government has promised assistance. Just pray that the government will follow through on its promises with funding.
- 7) for Rev and Mrs. Wright, who themselves been ill. Pray for their physical strength and stamina to keep the busy schedule they have in overseeing all this work. Pray that they will continue to be filled with the Holy Spirit.
